### Kindergarten Registrations for 2025-26

We will be accepting Kindergarten registrations for September 2025 starting January 20.

We are offering a morning class that is Monday through Thursday with alternating Friday mornings and an afternoon class Monday through Thursday with alternating Friday morning classes.

Students must be five years old as of December 31, 2025.

Registration forms will be available on our school website or through the Lethbridge School Division website.

To register your child, we will require a birth certificate (or copy of completed form to order a birth certificate and providing some other legal document with legal name and date of birth) and proof of address such as a utility bill in parent's name.

### Dropping Off and Picking Up Students

Absolutely no parking in the east and west Staff Parking Lots and the east alley. Please observe the No Parking zones in and around the school as well. This is a serious safety concern for our students, parents and staff. Thank you for observing all the signs posted.

Our Silent Auction and Gift Card Raffle at the Hurricanes Game on December 11, 2024 was a huge success!





# National Ribbon Skirt Day

Lethbridge school division will celebrate ribbon skirt/shirt day on Thursday January 9th, 2025.

## Wear your Ribbon skirt or ribbon shirt to school with pride!



In 2020 Isabella Kulak wore a Ribbon Skirt to her school formal day and was told she should have worn something more appropriate- something store bought, like the rest of the girls in her class. This incident left Isabella feeling very upset, but never ashamed. Her story went viral and inspired thousands of Indigenous people across Canada to wear their Ribbon Skirts and Shirts with pride!

Mary Jane McAllum, a member of Cree First Nation and Manitoba Senator, passed a Bill in 2020 that declared Jan. 4, 2023, as the first National Ribbon Skirt Day. The federal government shared a statement, reflecting that "this day is to learn more about and to celebrate Indigenous cultures, traditions, histories and contributions to Canada."
